### Number Ordering Game

What you will need? (Resources)

Empty plastic bottles

Pom poms

Felt tips

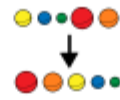
How to play the game? (Instructions)

1. Get 4 or 5 empty bottles, big bottles preferably.
2. Mark numbers on the bottles.
3. Then, using pom poms, get the child to put the right amount in each bottle.
4. Then support the child to put the numbers in the correct order.

Can I make it harder/easier? (Differentiation)

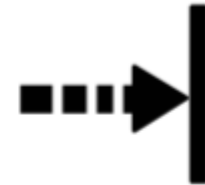
- To make it harder you could use more bottles and bigger numbers.
- You could mix the numbers up to see if they know which number is which.
- You could also use tweezers to put the pom poms in to support fine motor skills development.
