

# Shaving Foam



Shaving Foam is a really good item to have in a sensory box... children love how messy it is and parents seem to like that it isn't too difficult to clean up. Again you can make this simple (just shaving foam and a tray) or you can let your imagination run wild with different themes and colours.

## Things you will need....

- Shaving Foam or gel
- Some sort of tray – I used an old baking tray.

## Extras can include,

- Food colouring
- Glitter
- Powdered paint
- Paint brushes
- Added toys such as cars (great for mark making), animals etc

Again a lot of ideas and resources can be found on the internet, in supermarkets and on amazon and ebay.

When I did this activity with my own children they wanted to create a dinosaur world... we added dinosaurs, trees (from a train set we already had), glitter to create a snow effect and some blue food colouring. I just used an old baking tray to put everything in and I made sure I had some baby wipes to hand to clean any mess (you could use a bowl of water). When the activity was finished we got out paint brushes and my son decided to mark make in the foam. This ended up being a great opportunity to let him explore and show me the marks he could make. We even did some dinosaur foot prints. I have included some pictures in case you need ideas but you really can't go wrong.... Enjoy.
