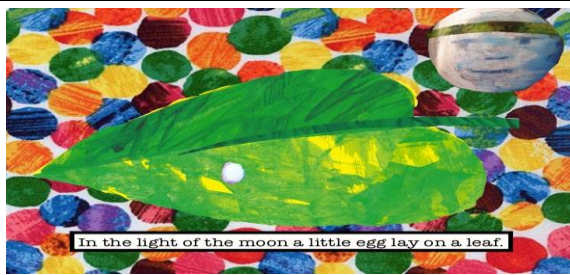




The Very Hungry Caterpillar

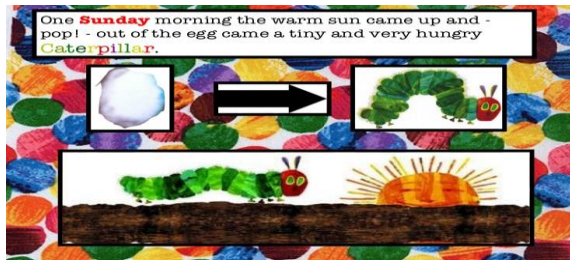

Circle



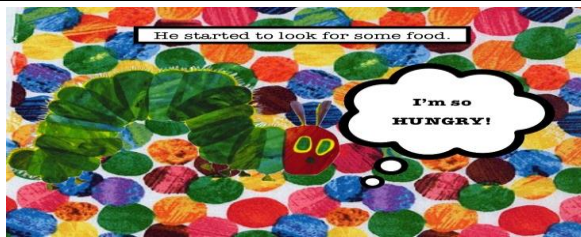
One **Sunday** morning the warm sun came up and - pop! - out of the egg came a tiny and very hungry Caterpillar.

But he was still hungry.



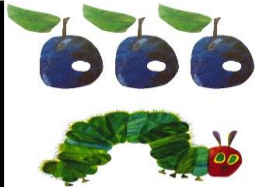
Squeeze

That night he had a stomachache!

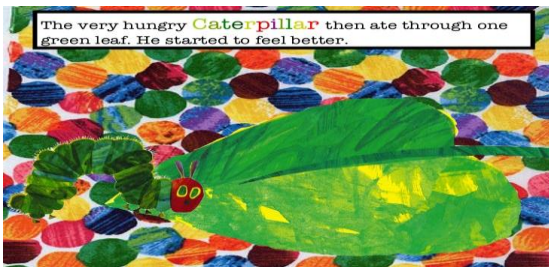


Squeeze
