Signalong Introductory Workshop

What is Signalong?

Signalong is a key word, sign-supported communication system based on British Sign Language and is used in spoken word order. It uses speech, sign, body language, facial expression and voice tone to reference the link between sign and word.

What the course offers

The workshop is frequently topic based and the emphasis is on the practical application of signing. We cover a brief history, philosophy and methodology of Signalong before teaching approximately 50 key words, but you will learn the necessary skills to read and produce any sign in our range of over 70 manuals. We will also provide activities to put the vocabulary into context i.e. sentence practice, plays etc.

The course consists of 2 afternoon sessions as detailed below—attendance at both is expected.

Signalong Foundation Training



What the Course offers

The Foundation Course develops skills to a level where practitioners can apply signing in their own environment and includes some elements of communication theory. It is a 15-hour course normally delivered over an extended period, and is the basic building block of SIGNALONG training and the Tutor training programme.

Course structure

The course runs for 7 x 2 hour sessions and attendance at all sessions is required in order to achieve certification.

The basic Signalong Manual is included in the cost of the course.

Developing Structure in EYFS to support



Pupils with SEND

Outline of course

This half day training is focused on the importance of structure for pupils with SEND and challenges typical models of provision to enable access, support inclusion and secure positive outcomes. Content of the half day session will include concepts such as person-centered practice, structuring pupils' learning experience and adult led/child led learning.

Moving and Handling Training

Outline of course

Our Centaur trained staff will offer training in 2 areas of moving and handling:

Safe practices for yourself whilst moving and handling

This will cover how to safely hold your body, keep the correct posture and use your body effectively whilst you move, handle and lift objects or support pupils with physical needs.

Using equipment to support moving and handling

This will cover the safe and effective use of equipment such as hoists and slings to safely and securely support pupils in moving and being repositioned into different equipment.

Adapting Resources for Pupils with SEND in the Mainstream Classroom

Differentiation is an integral part of successful teaching. For pupils with SEND, the differentiation often needs to take into account the specific learning needs of an individual child.

This half day training will look at a range of everyday classroom resources, which can be used to effectively differentiate learning activities to meet the needs of pupils with SEND.

Outline of course
