Supporting SEND in the Mainstream Classroom



Outline of course

For pupils with SEND, making the learning match the needs of the pupil and linking to the age appropriate curriculum can be difficult. This course will look at ways to consider the learning needs of pupils who have SEND when planning and teaching in English and Mathematics.

This half day training will support teachers to successfully identify starting points for pupils, who are not currently able to access age-related learning. You will look at how to make adaptations & adjustments to resources and curriculum.

Signalong Introductory Workshop

What is Signalong?

Signalong is a key word, sign-supported communication system based on British Sign Language and is used in spoken word order. It uses speech, sign, body language, facial expression and voice tone to reference the link between sign and word.

What the course offers

The workshop is frequently topic based and the emphasis is on the practical application of signing. We cover a brief history, philosophy and methodology of Signalong before teaching approximately 50 key words, but you will learn the necessary skills to read and produce any sign in our range of over 70 manuals. We will also provide activities to put the vocabulary into context i.e. sentence practice, plays etc.

The course consists of 2 sessions as detailed below—attendance at both is expected.

Parents and professionals. Anyone working with, or who is going to be working with, pupils who are using Signalong or who need a total communication environment.

Signalong Foundation Course

What is Signalong?

Signalong is a key word, sign-supported communication system based on British Sign Language and is used in spoken word order. It uses speech, sign, body language, facial expression and voice tone to reference the link between sign and word.

What the Course offers

The Foundation Course develops skills to a level where practitioners can apply signing in their own environment and includes some elements of communication theory. It is a 16-hour course normally delivered over an extended period, and is the basic building block of SIGNALONG training and the Tutor training programme.

Course structure

The course runs for 8 x 2 hour sessions and attendance at all sessions is required in order to achieve certification.

The basic Signalong manual is included in the cost of the course.

Positive Behaviour Support

Outline of the course:

This is a 9-hour course spread over 3 half days.

It looks at behaviour from a Positive Behaviour Support point of view.

The content of the sessions covers the following themes:

- Challenging behaviour
- Values
- Behaviour management and behaviour support
- The assault cycle and staff well-being
- Functional assessment and the use of data
- Hypotheses and proactive planning
- Quality of life and incident reduction
- Reactive strategies and restrictive intervention
- Restrictive practice

Target Audience

The content of the course is aimed at those who work with children with SEND and would be relevant to both mainstream colleagues and also those from special educational settings.
